He had been deputy chief medical officer of United Nations, visited/served in 32 countries, adjunct professor of Massachusetts Institute of Technology, (MIT) Zaragoza, Spain and adjunct research Professor- International Health Innovation Center, Ivey School of Business, Canada, consultant of National Disaster Management Authority. He was president and is fellow of Academy of Hospital Administration, founder director of International Institute of Health Management Research, chairman, Health Care Division of Quality Council of India. Developed European Foundation for Quality Management (EFQM) model for Healthcare in India released by Union Health Minister.

Presently, he is Managing Director of InnovatioCuris, Adjunct Professor-World Health Innovation Network, Odette School of Business, University of Windsor, Canada., Director of Healthcare Asia for Lean Healthcare Excellence-Simpler, chairman Indian Society Health Professionals, visiting professor of Indian Institute Management and Indian Institute of Technology and authored book “Innovations in Healthcare Management: Cost-Effective and Sustainable Solutions” that was published in USA in 2015.

Dr Sanjiv Kumar has 40 years of experience in public health in 29 countries in Central and South Asia, Eastern and Southern Africa, Central Eastern Europe and in academics. He started his career as MO in Indian Army. He worked at PHCs in Haryana, urban slums in Delhi, and in UNICEF as health specialist in India and then at international positions as Chief of Health, Nutrition, Child Survival & Development and Senior Advisor in Iraq, Kenya, Uganda and Somalia and Regional Advisor for 22 countries in Central Asia, Central and Eastern Europe. His public health work took him to deserts of Rajasthan, Masai villages in Kenya, post conflict areas of northern Uganda, war zone in Cambodia, and domestic fish ponds in Bangladesh, firing lines in Iraq; militancy torn Somalia and former Soviet republics after collapse of communism and so on. He has conducted strategic program reviews, planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of programs, capacity building of semi-literate village volunteers, to senior faculty of medical, nursing and paramedic colleges, strategic planning and managing of health programs for UNICEF in many countries. In 2011, he came back to academics and developed and facilitated courses for government officials and NGOs in leadership and strategic management for mid and senior level health officials and supervised research projects for reputed national and international organizations. His current interests are capacity building in leadership, strategic management team building for corporate sector, UN and health institutions. He currently heads National Health Systems Resource Centre that provides technical support to Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, state governments in India. He has published more than 100 papers in scientific and popular magazines and chapters in books.
